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MINIMUM MANAGEMENT OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PROP

broccoli

intermediate pattern

Yarn: Any DK weight yarn in dark green

Needles: 1 pair 3.75mm (UK) needles, sewing needle

Knitting:

Hat

Using 3.75mm needles cast on 29sts.

Row 1: K1 P1 to last st, K1 Row 2: P1 K1 to last st, P1

Work 12 rows in stocking stitch.

Next row: (K2tog) to last st, K1 (15sts) Next row: (P2tog) to last stitch P1 (8sts)

Cut yarn and thread through remaining stitches

and draw tight

Floret

Cast on 20 stitches and knit 1 row

Row 1: (K1 M1) to last stitch, k1 (39sts)

Knit 3 rows

Next row: (K1 M1) to last stitch, K1 (77sts)

Knit 3 rows Cast off

Making up

Sew up green hat and attach floret to the top.

Coil the floret randomly to make it look more broccoli-like.

Sew in all ends

Abbreviations K = Knit P = Purl Tog = Together Sts = stitches St st = stocking stitch k2tog = knit two together P2tog = purl two together M1 = Make a st by picking up the loop between two sts
